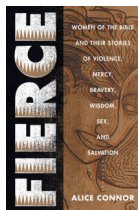

Book Club is gonna be *Fierce*!

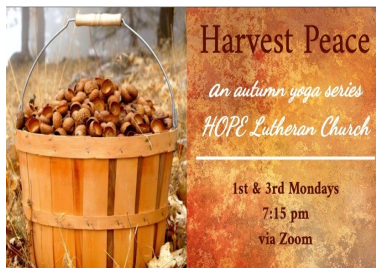
