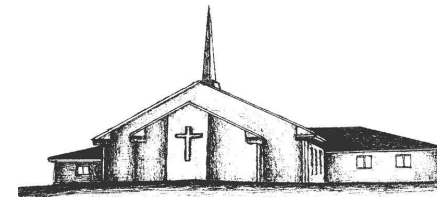

It represents the humiliation of Jesus and the consequences of sin as a preparation for the celebration of new life.*
